

## **OSUN GRADUATE RESEARCH MOBILITY PROGRAM**

- For **graduate students** (Master's and PhD programs) enrolled at an <u>OSUN</u> <u>member institution</u>. The mobility cannot take place after the completion of a graduate program.
- Relevance of research topic to **OSUN themes** is required <u>https://opensocietyuniversitynetwork.org/about/themes/</u>
- The **destination** of the research mobility can be any other OSUN member institution with **clear justification of the resources at the institution**, including academic materials, faculty experts, and/or community partners relevant to the subject of research.
- Funding available for research visits that range from **21 to120 days**;
- Available **scholarships** range from \$ 500 to \$ 6,000 and can cover airfare, accommodations, daily living expenses, insurance.
- Application must include an **invitation / endorsement letter** from the host institution. It is the applicant's responsibility to procure this letter.
- Calls for applications will be announced on the OSUN website <u>Graduate</u> <u>Mobility (opensocietyuniversitynetwork.org)</u>
